PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN HARPSWELL

In collaboration with Coastal Trans, a transportation provider which also operates the Brunswick Explorer, the Town of Harpswell will be offering a public transit service every Wednesday beginning May 27. The Coastal Trans bus will accommodate 12 passengers with space for two wheelchairs.

There will be two routes in Harpswell, both connecting with the Brunswick Explorer at Cook's Corner: (1) the Harpswell Connector will provide transportation connecting bus stops on Harpswell Neck, Orr's Island and Great Island with Cook's Corner multiple times each Wednesday; and (2) the Cundy's Harbor Express will operate three runs each Wednesday between Cundy's Harbor and Cook's Corner.

Connecting with the Brunswick Explorer will enable Harpswell riders to have access to all locations serviced by the Brunswick routes. Please see Harpswell and Brunswick schedules inside and note that there is no parking at the Holbrook location as parking is limited to their patrons only. Riders accessing from that location will need to make plans to be dropped off and picked up.

PROPERTY TAX ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Voters at the Annual Town Meeting amended the Town's Property Tax Assistance Ordinance to re-establish a program that provides property tax assistance to qualifying persons who reside in Harpswell. Under this program, the Town will issue refund payments to those individuals who qualify as recipients of the State of Maine Residents Property Tax Fairness Credit. Residents must file Form PTFC with Maine Revenue Services. In addition, residents must also submit an application to the Town's program by October 15 of each year. The Property Tax Fairness Credit replaces the State of Maine's former Circuit Breaker Program. 2015 Annual Town Meeting Highlights

Voters approved municipal appropriations of \$4,529,383, up 1.47% from prior year appropriations.

\$110,000 was authorized for a reserve fund for the purpose of the acquisition and defense of interests in the area of Cedar Beach, Cedar Island and the small beach on Merry's Cove, Bailey Island. Funds may be used to cover legal costs of the Cedar Beach/Cedar Island Supporters in its efforts to preserve public access over Cedar Beach Road to beach areas.

The Board of Selectmen was authorized to convey the West Harpswell School property to Harpswell Coastal Academy for total consideration of \$150,000, which occurred on April 15.

Elinor Multer was re-elected to the Board of Selectmen for a three-year term.

Ronald Ponziani was re-elected Road Commissioner for a three-year term.

Joanne Rogers was re-elected to the School Board for a three-year term.

Mitchell Field Boat Ramp

The Mitchell Field Committee has been developing a plan for a boat ramp at the Field. The master plan calls for a ramp and the Committee is now working on the details. Public meetings were held last winter to gather input from townspeople. Some of the findings from these meetings are listed below. By no means have all of the details been worked out at this point, and you are encouraged to contact the Committee or respond to a survey on the Town's website if you have further input. The Committee hopes to have a proposal ready for Town Meeting in 2016. The Committee is planning to present information to the non-resident taxpayers at their July 7 meeting. Key points that have been made to the Committee are:

- The ramp should be large enough to accommodate lobster-boat-sized vessels. This would include a low water depth at the bottom of the ramp of 3-4 feet.
- The presence of a ramp at Mitchell Field could encourage a marine business to locate there.

- Matching funds from the State will probably be required to make it affordable. These funds will require that the ramp be open to the general public and, based on input received, this is felt to be appropriate.
- Fees for use are also felt to be appropriate and details of how this might be done are still being discussed. Ideas include a "recycling sticker" approach for residents and an automated "parking garage" ticket for non-residents.
- The relationship between the ramp and the existing pier is still an issue requiring a decision as part of the final proposal.
- This is a work in progress and is still very much open for further input. Ultimately, the Committee's recommendation will be referred to the Selectmen.
- An upcoming Town-wide meeting will be scheduled for later in the summer.
