- **Previous months minutes reviewed and approved.**
- David and Kevin have walked Ash Cove. Kevin also found the septic was new in 2008. Further investigation likely required.
- Monique having a hard time getting a hold of Army Corps (Update from after meeting: Scott Moody has talked with Army Corps.)
- Scott Moody will be a new committee member (Selectmen to vote 9/29)
