ARTICLE 2

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to exchange quitclaim deeds with Hamilton Starr in order to clarify the property boundary between the Mackerel Cove Town Landing Property (Tax Map 22, Lot 55) and Hamilton Starr's abutting property on Abner Point Road (Tax Map 22, Lot 57) as follows:

- (a) The Board of Selectmen to release to Hamilton Starr all of the Town's right, title and interest in that portion of Tax Map 22, Lot 57 depicted as Area "A" on a marked-up copy of a survey of Mackerel Cove Town Landing by MidCoast Survey Co. dated November 17, 2015 ("MidCoast Survey"), a copy of which is on file at the office of the Town Clerk;
- (b) Hamilton Starr to release to the Town all of his right, title and interest in another portion of Map 22, Lot 57 depicted as Area "B" on said MidCoast Survey; and
- (c) Hamilton Starr to pay the Town the sum of \$3,000.

ARTICLE 3

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into the following transaction with Richard C. Lamon and Darlene Lamon (the "Lamons") regarding property located on Harpswell Tax Map 22, Lot 55, commonly known as the Mackerel Cove Town Landing Property (the "Town Landing Property"), for the purpose of establishing the rights of the Lamons and the Town in and to the Town Landing Property as follows:

- (a) The Lamons to release by quitclaim deed to the Town all of their right, title and interest in the Town Landing Property as depicted on a survey of Mackerel Cove Town Landing by MidCoast Survey Co. dated November 17, 2015 ("MidCoast Survey");
- (b) The Board of Selectmen to subsequently convey an easement to the Lamons, consisting of an 8-foot wide strip of land along the westerly boundary of the Town Landing Property from Abner Point Road to the water, as depicted on a marked-up copy of the MidCoast Survey (a copy of which is on file at the office of the Town Clerk); for the purpose of dinghy storage and access to the water, and with certain further limitations and restrictions agreed upon by the parties;
- (c) The Town to appropriate the sum of \$4,000 from unassigned fund balance to pay the Lamons.
