



GETTING STARTED:

When: Choose highest tide for month. Use the Tide sheet attached or check tide using **South Harpswell** location, <http://usharbors.com/tide-charts> The Maine DEP highest annual tide (HAT) level for 2018 at Harpswell's Potts Harbor is 11.6 feet.



Take photos: Follow instructions on the post and take photos. Note Hotspot Name. *Don't forget to make safety a top priority! Never put yourself in harm's way to take a photo!*

Upload photos using your computer:

1. Log in to Anecdata.org on your computer.
2. Select **Harpswell King Tides Impact** project.
3. Select **+Add Observation** in blue box.
4. Enter date and time the photos were taken in **Observation time** box.
5. Select **Use a hotspot** and select appropriate location from the list and enter **+Select**.
6. Enter Tide Stage, Wind direction and other information as appropriate.
7. Select **Add Photo** and insert the photos you have taken. Photos are inserted one at a time. Insert in the order photos were taken.
8. Select **Save** in the bottom blue box.


Upload photos using your smartphone:

1. Open the Anecdata app on your iPhone or Android device.
2. Click on **Joined** and select **Harpswell King Tide Impacts**.
3. Click on **+ Observe** in the header.
4. The Observe screen will be displayed. First line of the screen will either indicate "No location chosen" or display your latitude and longitude.



Click on the Location line.

5. Click on "Pick from list" at the bottom of the screen and select appropriate location from the list.
6. Enter date and time the photos were taken in **Date/time** box.
7. Enter **Tide Stage**, **Wind direction** and other information as appropriate.
8. Select **Add Photo** and insert the photos you have taken from your phone's **Camera roll**. Photos are inserted one at a time. Insert in the order photos were taken.
9. Select **Save** at the top right hand of the screen.
