

**WARRANT
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
HARPSWELL, MAINE
November 6, 2007**

To any Constable or Resident of the Town of Harpswell:

You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Harpswell qualified to vote in Town affairs to assemble at (1) Merriconeag Grange, 529 Harpswell Neck Road, for voters who reside on Harpswell Neck; (2) Cundy's Harbor Community Building, 837 Cundy's Harbor Road, for voters who reside on Great Island; and (3) Orr's Island Community Building, 1594 Harpswell Islands Road, for voters who reside on Orr's and Bailey Islands, on Tuesday, the sixth day of November, 2007 at 9:00am of said day, to act on Article 1.

Art. 1 – To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

(POLLS WILL OPEN AS SOON AS ARTICLE ONE HAS BEEN ACTED UPON AND WILL CLOSE AT 8:00 P.M.)

Art. 2 – To vote by secret ballot on the following Referendum Question:

To see if the Town will vote to adopt the Mitchell Field Master Plan dated September 13, 2007 as proposed by the Mitchell Field Committee.

[The proposed Mitchell Field Master Plan is available for review and inspection at the Town Clerk's Office and the Planning Office.]

Note: The Mitchell Field Master Plan is a conceptual guide to future uses at Mitchell Field. Implementation of specific elements of the Plan and any associated costs will require subsequent Town Meeting approval.

Art. 3 – To vote by secret ballot on the following Referendum Question:

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$35,000 from undesignated fund balance to be used by the Maine Department of Transportation for certain additional work and materials necessary for the possible relocation of the public utilities at the Cribstone Bridge from overhead to underground (under the sidewalk), which relocation work would require subsequent Town Meeting approval.

Recommended by Selectmen

The Selectmen hereby give notice that the Registrar of Voters will be available at the Town Office during regular business hours for the entire week preceding said meeting to receive applications of persons claiming the right to vote at said meeting and to make corrections to the list of voters. Registrations will be accepted at the meeting.
