

**Special Selectmen's Meeting**  
**Minutes of March 2, 2015**  
Approved March 18, 2015

**Selectmen Present:** Richard A. Daniel, Elinor Multer and Kevin E. Johnson

**Also Present:** Kristi Eiane, Town Administrator and Marguerite Kelly, Town Treasurer

Chairman Daniel opened the meeting at 7:05pm.

**Resignations**

Chairman Daniel moved to accept the resignations of Eric Chipman and Frank Hilton from the Emergency Vehicles Committee. It was seconded by Selectman Johnson and passed 3-0.

**Appointments**

Chairman Daniel moved to appoint David Mercier, Frank True, Jr., and Steve Galhardo to the Emergency Vehicles Committee. It was seconded by Selectman Johnson and passed 3-0.

**Authorization of the Warrant**

Chairman Daniel moved to approve postage in an amount not to exceed \$900 for the mailing of the Annual Town Report. It was seconded by Selectman Johnson and passed 3-0.

**Joint Session with Emergency Vehicles Committee**

At approximately 7:10pm, the Board was joined by members of the Emergency Vehicles Committee [David Mercier, Frank True, Ben Wallace, Jonathan Burbank, Walter Johnson and Steve Galhardo], other members of the public [EMA Rob McAleer, Lisa True and Gail Hart of the Harpswell Neck Fire Department], and Ron Morin, of Sugarloaf Ambulance/Rescue Vehicles, to discuss matters related to the construction of an ambulance for the Town that will be leased to the Harpswell Neck Fire Department. After much discussion, the Emergency Vehicles Committee voted on the following recommendations: (1) return to a standard suspension (not liquid suspension because of incompatibility with the tire chains); (2) use 2" lettering on the rear door in script to read: *Provided by Town of Harpswell*; and (3) add same script lettering, at no cost, to the other two ambulances previously purchased by the Town. At its next regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, March 5, 6:00pm, the Board of Selectmen will consider these recommendations in the form of a change order to the contract between the Town and Sugarloaf Ambulance/Rescue Vehicles.
