

Bulk Materials

Transfer Station
Located up the hill
and closes earlier
than the Recycling
Center. Weigh
vehicle upon entry &
exit to determine fee.
There is no free disposal
at T/S. there is
a minimum \$1.20
disposal fee.

- construction & demolition debris
- Furniture, mattresses,
- Appliances (if Freon, flat \$15 fee)*
- large metal items
- tires (Flat fee \$4/tire and up)
- large batteries (e.g. auto)
- NO ASH—We recommend composting
- brush, wood, leaves & yard waste
- propane tanks (\$3 & \$20)

*Refrigerator doors must be removed for safety reasons (Federal regs) if not removed, additional \$3

Bulk Material Fees: (see above for tires & freon items like refrig.)

Separated Material (wood, metal, brush, etc.) - **\$0.06/lb. = \$120/ton**

Unseparated Material - **\$0.12/lb. = \$240/ton**

Our town must pay to haul and dispose of the Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) and Construction & Demolition debris (C&D) at a landfill or incinerator. Recycling & composting offset some of this cost. Our goal is to minimize our solid waste output and through proper separation, recycle & compost more than 65% of our town's waste. **Help keep Harpswell beautiful and taxes low!** Please recycle & compost, by doing your part you can make a difference.

Mandatory Recycling & Waste Disposal Guidelines





CARDBOARD

PLACE IN SINGLE STREAM HOPPER
Clean corrugated cardboard. Please flatten large boxes.

PAPER

PLACE IN SINGLE STREAM HOPPER
Newsprint and all newspaper enclosures, telephone books, soft & hard cover books, computer paper, Brown paper bags, pasteboard, wrapping paper, colored paper, envelopes, index cards, manila folders, junk mail, post-it notes, school & office paper, spiral bound notebooks

CANS

PLACE IN SINGLE STREAM HOPPER
Clean steel cans, aluminum cans, aerosol cans, aluminum foil, metal jar lids, bottle caps. OK if labels left on but appreciate removal.

GLASS

PLACE IN SINGE STREAM HOPPER
Clean jars & bottles - any color.
NO clay, porcelain or ceramics - PLACE IN TRASH HOPPER
Plate glass from windows to Transfer Station.

PLASTICS #1-7

PLACE IN SINGLE STREAM HOPPER
Cleaned/drained containers only.
No Styrofoam, plastic bags or rigid plastics larger than 5 gallon buckets. Larger plastic items must go the Transfer Station
Styrofoam and plastic bags - PLACE IN TRASH HOPPER.

KITCHEN WASTE

ADM encourages either home composting or central composting located at the Recycling Center. Trash should be a last resort. (see manager for further info.)

RETURNABLES

Refunds on metal, glass & plastic containers will go to the Town to offset taxes. Thank you for your donation.

METAL & WOOD

Slots are intended for small household items, No C & D, no multiple items, Items can not exceed 10 lbs.

**LARGE ITEMS OVER 10 LBS OR
TOO LARGE FOR THE SLOT MUST
BE TAKEN TO THE TRANSFER
STATION**

USED CLOTHING

Good used clothes, belts & shoes: Take to Goodwill (Brunswick) or utilize Salvation Army boxes in Parking Lot.

YARD WASTE

Please compost any yard waste such as Grass & leaves, if not Take yard waste and brush to the Transfer Station.

BATTERIES

Rechargeable batteries only. Disposable batteries to Trash. Wet cell batteries (e.g. automobile) must be taken to the Transfer Station.

WASTE OIL

Place in sealed containers in marked area. Oil filters- drain and place in trash. NO BILGE WATER, NO FUEL, NO PAINT, NO ANTIFREEZE, NO HAZMAT MATERIALS.

PAINT CANS

Cans must be empty, dry and without cover. Place in trash. NO FULL OR PARTIALLY FULL PAINT CANS, these can be taken to Sherwin Williams for recycling.

UNIVERSAL WASTE

TVs/ Monitors/ laptops/ tablets (\$5 each)
Non-leaking PCB ballasts (\$2 each)
Fluorescent tubes, CFL bulbs (\$1 each)
Mercury Thermostats & meters (\$1 each)
Computer towers & small printers & copiers (\$1 each)
