

Bandstand Committee Meeting

Minutes of April 13, 2022

Committee Members Present: Bob Modr, Chris Hall, Bryan Foster, Bill Muldoon, Gary Downes, and Gina Perow.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 9:01 am. The minutes from the March 16 meeting were approved unanimously. The following items were discussed:

Bandstand Maintenance: New solar panels have not yet been installed; we need to fill out a questionnaire and send it to Revision. Also, we need to get on Ray's Electronics' schedule for building and wiring the external electrical box.

Contractors: Gina noted that a Town policy requires that all non-employees working for the Town are "independent contractors", and need to fill out a form stating that they do not need worker's compensation. So we need all bands to do this, unless they have their own insurance. Gina or Terri will send the form to the bands.

Food Trucks: Sylvester's Fish and Chips is not available; they need at least a two-day event. Taco the Town is willing to come, but will charge \$150 per hour, in addition to whatever they sell. The Committee agreed (with one dissension) to hire them for two hours for the Primo Cubano concert (August 25). We will need to promote the fact that food will be available at that concert.

Personnel: Bob Modr will be stepping down as Chair of the Committee. He will continue to be a member.

Publicity: The brochures, posters, and post cards are ready to print as soon as we have a decision on the food truck (which we now have).

Fundraising: Bill asked the Committee to think about ideas for fundraising. For example, we could possibly ask Maine State Music Theater to donate a couple of tickets.

Parking: Is it up to us, or the Mitchell Field Committee to designate and monitor parking areas at the Field?

Personnel: Bob Modr will be stepping down as Chair of the Committee. He will continue to be a member.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 9:55 am.
